
To provide students with an opportunity to explore the arts beyond the classroom curriculum. One of our main goals is to learn about art and how it influences, and is influenced by, the world around us.

Mission: Create news, opinion, and feature articles for Rhinebeck Reality student newspaper.







Environmental Club aims to increase environmental awareness and action among its members as well as the entire school community.



Advisor: Mrs. Alyssa Barnes




Mission: STEM Club is designed engage students in challenges across areas of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics.

## Mission:


